# Why use this sheet?

When the pointer enters the RED scale there are less than 30 doses left. When it hits zero the whole device will lock up so you can't turn it. Take empty inhaler to your Pharmacy for recycling. Ask your pharmacist to PRIME the inhaler for you as this can be difficult to do.

# **Inhaler Administration Steps**

## Prepare the device

- 1. Turn the clear base until it click (half a turn).
- 2. Open the cap.

### Get ready to inhale

- 3. Turn the clear base until it click (half a turn).
- 4. Open the cap.
- 5. Breathe out fully away from the device.
- 6. Put the mouthpiece in your mouth between your teeth and close your lips around it to make a good seal.
- 7. Start to take a slow, deep breath through your mouth.
- 8. Press the dose release button and continue to breathe in slowly for as long as you can until you feel your lungs are full.
- 9. Hold your breath for 5 to 10 seconds.
- 10. Repeat steps 1 to 7 as prescribed.
